- 1. Sign the back of your ticket.
- 2. Complete and sign the claim form.
- 3. For claims over \$599, you will be required to produce a valid ID for identification purposes:
  - State Issued Driver's License Military Identification Card State Issued Identification Card
  - Voter's Registration Identification Card Alien Registration Receipt Card Passport
- 4. The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) requires a winner to provide proof of U.S. Social Security Number (SSN) or U.S. Tax Identification Number (TIN) for all prizes greater than \$599.
